INSTRUCTIONS TO UG / PG / PG-CSS / MBA / LLM STUDENTS **INCLUDED IN THE HOSTEL ALLOTMENT LIST**

1. The students shall report for admission before the Warden of concerned Hostel on or before **07.04.2024**.
2. **The parent/local guardian must be present at the time of admission.** In the absence of the parent, the letter nominating the local guardian duly signed by the parent should be produced.
3. The students shall submit the following documents at the time of admission:
 - i. Printout of the hostel application form.
 - ii. Copy of Admit Card of the programme / course they have joined.
 - iii. Documentary evidence substantiating their claims. [Address / Caste / BPL (BPL Certificate issued by the Government Authority must be submitted; BPL ration card will not be accepted) / Differently abled].
4. If the required **documentary proofs justifying their claims are not produced at the time of admission, the candidate shall be eliminated from the list and shall not be considered for future allotments.**
5. Those students who are not being able to follow the schedule of admission, shall contact the hostel office.
